YOUR GIFT HAS AN IMPACT TODAY, AND FOR A LIFETIME

Widows Training Grants

Fund the training to teach these women the work skills and financial management to establish and manage a small business such as baking, soap making, sewing, subsistence farming, and petty-trading which can sustain their needs and those of their families. We have arranged with an entrepreneurial and co-operative education agency in Nigeria to train them at a subsidized rate.

\$30 will train one widow.

Widows Small Business Grants

Once the training program is completed, we hope to help newly trained widows realize their potential by providing them with small business grants (approximately \$200 each) to help them on the road to self-sufficiency.

A donation of any amount will help this fund grow.

Orphan Educational Grants

To help the next generation rise from the poverty and despair into which they were born, this education grant program will enable these innocent children have some basic education by funding their elementary through high school fees.

This grant approach is not intended to be inclusive of all expenses (e.g., uniforms, books, health, higher education and other educational needs).

Awards will be given on the basis of merit and excellence. We have currently identified about 50 of these children in need of assistance through sponsorship.

\$100 will sponsor one child's basic school fees for one academic year.

Sick and Elderly Widow Sponsorships

Many widows are aged and sickly, unable to work and have no means of support. They lack proper nutrition, needed medications, and the basics of survival.

\$30 a month/\$360 a year will sponsor one sickly widow and her basic needs.
